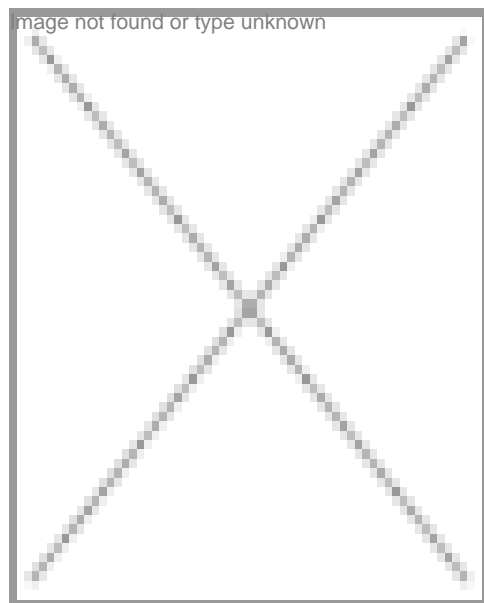


Jamie Wasserman Named to Leadership Broward Foundation Board of Directors
